2004



ENP acquires **Marconi** outside plant and power system – expanding telecom industry solutions.

Vertiv completes its first three acquisitions, Energy Labs, a U.S.-based manufacturer of custom air handling systems, Geist, a leading manufacturer of rack power distribution units, and the service contracts of MEMS, a UK power generation maintenance business.

2016



Vertiv launches as stand-alone business, building on the success of Emerson's past while expanding capabilities and commitment to support the mission of designing, building and servicing mission-critical technologies that drive possibility for our customers.

ENP acquires **Avocent** – provider of service processor and data center management software and KVM solutions.

ENP acquires Germany-based **Knürr AG** – leading provider of enclosure systems.

2021



Vertiv acquires E&I Engineering, completing its portfolio of in-building power train offerings for data centers and the commercial and industrial market.

2023



Vertiv acquires **CoolTera Ltd.** liquid cooling business, expanding the thermal management portfolio in support of cooling AI servers and high-density compute.

2024



Vertiv acquires **BSE** centrifugal chiller technology and heat-recovery and reuse solutions business.

2025



Vertiv and **Tecogen** partner on natural gas-powered chillers for data centers.
